This working lunch presentation will provide an overview of the history of and diagnostic criteria for Munchausen's Syndrome by Proxy (also known as Fictitious Disorder by Proxy and Pediatric Condition Falsification). This is a controversial subject, with experts polarized with regard to the incidence of this unusual form of child abuse, methods of treatment and prognosis. These subjects will be explored along with suggestions for more effective identification and treatment of medically related child abuse. Time will be provided for questions and dialogue with the presenter.

Eric G. Mart, Ph.D. is an internationally known authority on Munchausen's Syndrome by Proxy. he is the author of *Munchausen's Syndrome by Proxy Reconsidered* and a number of scholarly papers on the subject. Dr. Mart has testified in many high-profile cases involving MSBP allegations throughout the United States and Canada. He has appeared on *20/20*, *Court TV*, *BBC Radio* and been interviewed by publications such as the *New York Times*, *New Yorker* and *The New Scientist*.
