**Ray Pastorino**, clinical psychologist, oversees the behavioral science curriculum at the Alaska Family Medicine Residency. He spent 12 years in Juneau, Alaska, working with the University of Alaska and the State as an attorney, administrative hearing officer and professor. He returns to Alaska from Pocatello, Idaho, where he was faculty and vice chair with the Idaho State University's Family Practice Residency. Ray's background in law and behavioral psychology and his strong rural Alaskan ties make him an invaluable asset to Alaska. His passions include conflict resolution, cultural competency, integrated medicine, traditional healing, and patient-centered care.
